

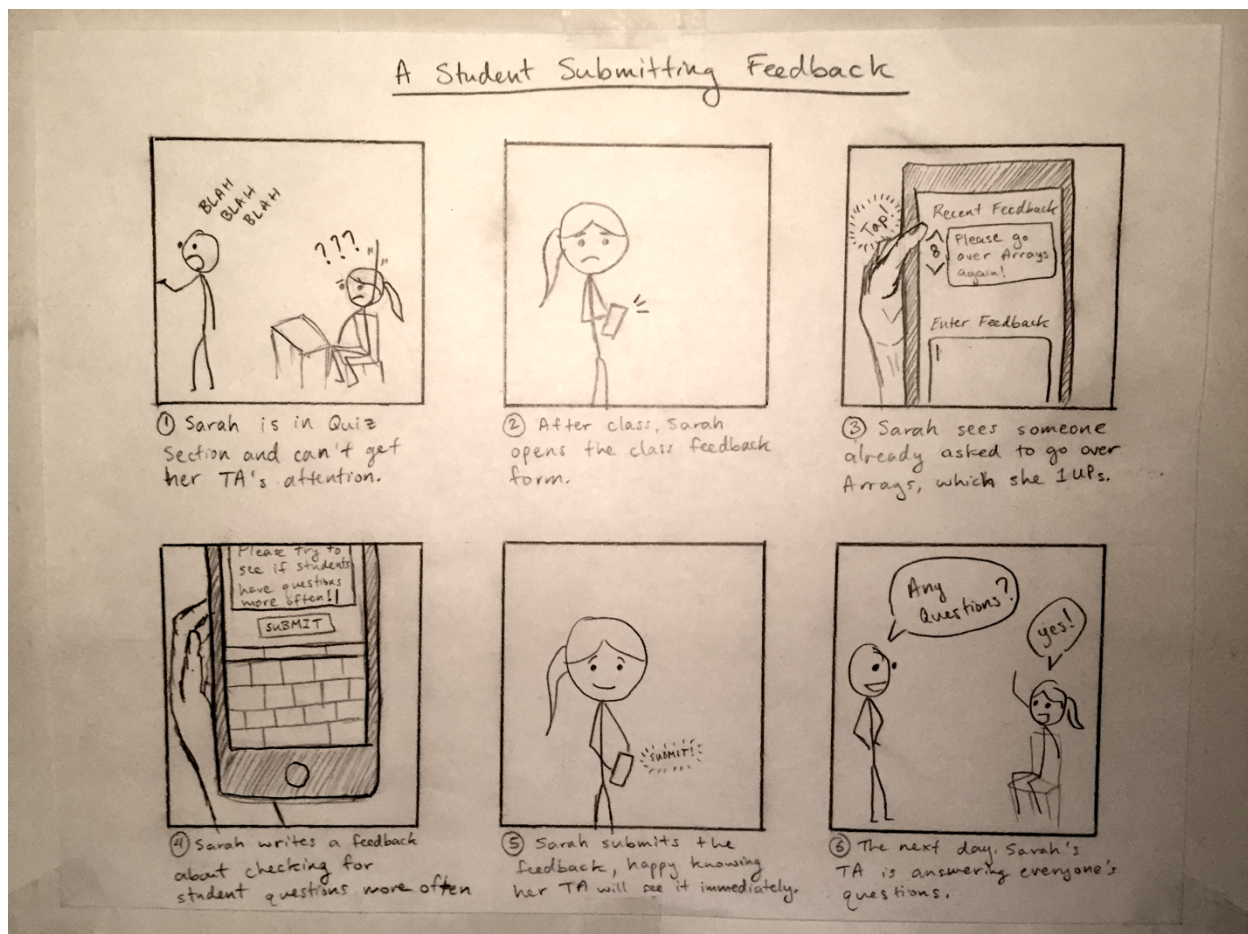
Storyboards

For our project, we are designing a tool for instructors to improve as teachers by allowing for high engagement with their students via an easy to use feedback system. Our application consists of a four-step process.

First, a student would submit a text feedback to the class's feedback form link. Second, that feedback would then be added to the TA's Recent Feedback dashboard where he/she/they can accept or reject based on if they want to make this feedback a Skill they want to work on. Third, our application would generate a survey based on the TA's list of Current Skills that will be sent out to students to see if the TA is improving on these skills or not. Fourth, after the students fill out the survey, the TA will be able to see how he/she/they are doing in the Results page.

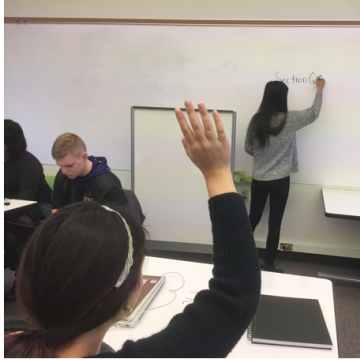
This application will allow for TAs to have a system to support their improvements as a teacher and let students have a more fruitful engagement with their TA.

Sketched Storyboard

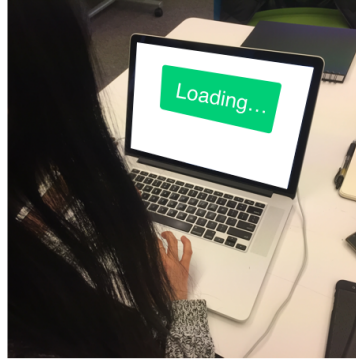

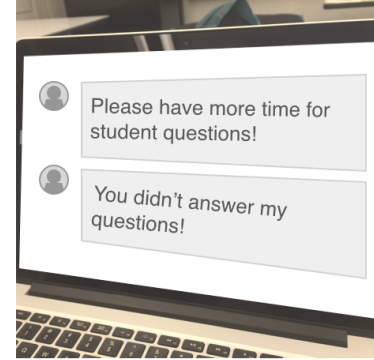
A TA Discovering Class Issues Through Feedback



1) Jackie, a TA for CSE 143, is teaching her quiz section, constantly looking down at the textbook, oblivious of her student's raised hands.



2) Later that day, Jackie opens her TA app to check her latest student feedback.



3) Jackie sees that multiple students have submitted feedback asking her to take more time to answer student's questions.



4) Surprised by this feedback, Jackie feels frustrated that she was oblivious of this problem so she sets it as a goal.



5) The next week, Jackie makes sure to check for questions often during section!
